- the Western Bluebird (*Sialia mexicana*) was a common inhabitant in oak-prairie and other open habitats in western Washington and southwestern British Columbia
- habitat loss, fragmentation and competition for nest cavities severely reduced their population in the early 1900s
- since 2007, the Western Bluebird has been the subject of an international reintroduction project ...**learn more!**
