

Osprey Nests

Puget Sound Energy Avian Protection Plan staff has informed Whidbey Audubon Society that they will be doing maintenance work this coming week, March 6-9, 2017, on the large osprey nest pole on Highway 525, near Classic Rd. The birds return mid April and the work will be completed by the end of March.

Osprey return to the same location but are very capable of rebuilding a nest if winter storms or other events have altered or destroyed their nest.
